THE CHALLENGE.

In the spring of 2023, Gateways were looking for an IT provider, specialising in education, to bring stability and future vision to the IT infrastructure at the school. Having already spent £30,000 on replacement wireless hardware that had remained in its box for six months, one of the first projects was for Holker to look at the installation of the new network.

As part of the overall support strategy, Gateways needed a partner to take charge of the management of their IT systems and network.

Circumstances meant their previous IT provider could take months to resolve issues, allowing day-to-day problems such as broken printers to accumulate and remain unsolved. This disrupted teaching and learning and was becoming increasingly stressful for the staff.
